First Semester (January – June)
January
( ) Check water (quantity, container integrity) ( ) Inspect food supplies (expiration dates)
February
<ul><li>( ) Test flashlights, batteries, and radios</li><li>( ) Check medicines and first-aid kit</li><li>( ) Verify first-aid training: plan a refresher if needed (e.g., via samaritans.ch)</li></ul>
March
( ) Update documents and contact lists ( ) Check seasonal clothing and blankets ( ) Test evacuation plan: conduct a family drill (routes, meeting point), verify plan for pets
April
<ul> <li>( ) Review specific needs (babies, seniors, pets)</li> <li>( ) Check accessibility devices: readability of large-print or Braille labels, functioning of visual/vibrating alarms</li> <li>( ) Inspect basic tools: condition of multi-tool knife, duct tape, and tools (hammer, screwdriver)</li> </ul>
( ) Clean and organize storage area  May
( ) Check garbage bags, gloves, and masks

( ) Update community contacts: verify neighbors' numbers, area chief, and civil protection officer

<ul> <li>( ) Rotate food supplies (FIFO principle)</li> <li>( ) Inspect shelter or cellar</li> <li>( ) Check pest protection: condition of non-toxic traps, stock of repellents</li> </ul>
Second Semester (July – December)
July
<ul> <li>( ) Recharge power banks and backup phones</li> <li>( ) Check water and opened canned goods</li> <li>( ) Update Alertswiss app (latest version) and digital backups: verify passwords / encryption for USB drive and cloud storage</li> </ul>
August
( ) Adapt kit to the season (summer / travel) ( ) Test battery or hand-crank radio
September  ( ) Update printed checklist ( ) Check headlamp and children's games
October
<ul> <li>( ) Add warm clothing and blankets</li> <li>( ) Check severe weather equipment: sturdy umbrella, plastic tarp, rope, protective goggles, compact sleeping bag</li> <li>( ) Inspect auxiliary heating and camping stove</li> <li>( ) Check chemical hand warmers: stock, expiration date, instructions for use</li> <li>( ) Inspect basic tools: maintain multi-tool knife, tighten screws, replace worn parts</li> </ul>
November
( ) Check medicines, iodine tablets, and first-aid kit ( ) Clean shelter / ventilation system



## December

( ) Check winter supplies ( ) Recharge power banks and spare batteries
⚠ After an Incident (power outage, flood, storm, etc.)
<ul> <li>( ) Replenish consumed supplies</li> <li>( ) Note what was missing or needs improvement</li> <li>( ) Update contact list (neighbors / local authorities)</li> <li>( ) Check condition of equipment (flashlights, batteries, stove, radio)</li> </ul>
